

ANNOUNCEMENT TO SHIPPING IJmond North Sea Canal Area Central Nautical Management 6

Subject: Works in the Australiehaven en Aziehaven

The Director of the Central Nautical Management North Sea Canal Area, who is also the (State) Harbour Master, announces the following:

Period: 15 October 2024 to 1 November 2024

For the realisation of a new berth for Graniet Import in the Aziehaven, the following activities will be carried out in the Australiehaven en Aziehaven:

- in the period 15 October 01 November, 2 mooring posts in the Australiehaven (Graniet Import berth B, AU GRB) will be dismantled, pulled and relocated in the Aziehaven. A trowel pole will also be placed on the west side of these piles. On the quay between bollards 21 and 22, 2 new bollards will be placed.
- on 15 October, preparatory work will be carried out in the Aziehaven for the installation of 2 temporary mooring posts and 1 temporary mooring post.
- in the period from 23 October to 25 October, bollard "A" will be pulled into the Aziehaven and permanently removed.
- -In mid-April 2025, the mooring posts and bollard in the Aziehaven will be replaced by permanent mooring facilities and the 2 mooring posts will be placed back in the Australiehaven.

Working hours

The work will be carried out from Monday to Friday from 06:00 to 1700 hours.

The workboats involved in this project are on standby on the block channel VHF channel 3

-Impact on shipping

- the berth AU GRB will be temporarily discontinued in the period from 15 October 2025 April 2025 in the period from 15 October 2024 to 1 November 2024 inclusive: setting up a work area marked with 4 yellow barrels with top sign A1 and a fixed white light
- -During the work, the poles are marked by a so-called 1000 hours lamp and a radar reflector
- the work area is closed to all shipping traffic except for work vessels/the supply of contractor material intended for the execution of work on this project;
- -During the aforementioned period, a ban has been imposed on causing annoying wave motion.
